VOLUNTARY PROGRAM FOR ACCESS TO THE TEAMSTERS 688 HEALTH & MEDICAL CAMP FOR HERCULANEUM RESIDENTS

This program is an agreement between the City of Herculaneum and Teamster Local 688 Insurance & Welfare Board of Trustees. Whereas, Herculaneum residents have the opportunity to enroll in the program that will allow access to the Teamsters Camp on a voluntary basis to enjoy the amenities the facility has to offer. The City of Herculaneum is the administrator of the program and the Teamsters Camp will manage, maintain and operate the facility.

The voluntary program is open to legal residents of Herculaneum currently paying a monthly city water bill. The cost of the program is a monthly fee of \$25.00 assessed to your monthly water bill. All participating households are required to enroll for period of 12 months. Identification cards are issued to all family members legally residing at the participating household age 16 years and older. Children under the age of 16 must enter the facility with a camp card holder within a licensed vehicle. Walk-ins, bicycles, ATV's etc. are not admissible. Each camp card holder is allowed one vehicle per visit. All guests must enter within that vehicle.

Among the amenities offered at the camp are an 18-hole golf course, a water park (pool), picnic pavilions and picnic grounds, a fishing lake, an athletic field, biking and walking trails, RV and tent campgrounds, clubhouse restaurant, facility rentals and annual events (ex. Family Camping Weekend, Car Show, Hawaiian Luau, Halloween Hayride and Haunted Mansion, etc.). Additional fees are required for golf and swimming.

Any Herculaneum resident wanting to participate in the voluntary program, should complete a registration form. Registration forms will be available at Herculaneum City Hall or on-line at www.cityofherculaneum.org. Completed registration forms should be submitted to Herculaneum City Hall by April 10, 2015. Camp cards will be mailed to residents prior to the program start date.
