HERCULANEUM FIRE DEPARTMENT TO HOST BOATER SAFETY EDUCATION CLASS - MAY 1

The Herculaneum Fire Department will host a Missouri Water Patrol Boater Safety Education class on Sunday, May 1 at the Herculaneum fire station, 151 Riverview Plaza Drive. The class will begin at 9:00 am and end at 3:00 pm.

Any person born after January 1, 1984 and who operates a vessel on the lakes of Missouri must possess, on the vessel, a boating safety identification card issued by the Water Patrol Division of the Missouri State High Patrol or its agent.

Registration for the class must be completed on the Missouri State Highway Patrol web site at: www.mshp.dps.mo.gov Click on the Boater Safety Education tab on the right side of the home page. Deadline to register is April 30.

Participation in the class is free of charge, but there will be a \$15.00 fee required for the issue of the identification card.

CITY PERMITS REQUIRED

The City of Herculaneum Building Department reminds all residents that most building and remodeling projects require permits. All projects involving framing, plumbing and electrical are required to be permitted. Projects including decks, swimming pools (2 feet or more in depth), hot tubs, retaining walls, fences, driveways, accessory structures (garages, carports, portable storage buildings) and finished basements all require permits. Permits are also required for the demolition of structures.

Occupancy of a residence or commercial building also requires city permits.
