ELECTRONIC RECYCLING ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 9

The City of Herculaneum Recycling Committee in partnership with Midwest Recycling Center will sponsor an electronic recycling event on Saturday, September 9 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. The recycling event will be held at the Herculaneum City Park, 776 Joachim Avenue. The event is open to all residents of the city of Herculaneum and the surrounding communities.

Acceptable items at no charge include: computers, monitors, printers, keyboards, laptops, hard drives, cell phones, pagers, radios, scanners, speakers, VCR players, DVD players, fax machines, answering machines, stereos, furnaces, water heaters, air conditioners, microwaves, power tools, kitchen appliances, camera equipment, restaurant equipment, medical equipment, lab equipment, machinery, most batteries, lawn and garden equipment (gas and oil must be removed prior to drop off).

There are fees required for the following: CRT TVs 26" or less - \$30.00, CRT TVs 27" or greater - \$50.00, any size wood console & big screen/projection TVs - \$50.00 and CRT monitors - \$5.00. The fee for Freon containing items is \$10.00.

The following items will not be accepted: alkaline batteries, CDs, VHS tapes, Hazardous Material, PCB containing ballasts, light bulbs and smoke detectors.

24th ANNUAL JEFFCO FIRE ENGINE RALLY SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 30

The 24th Annual Jeffco Fire Engine Rally will be held on Saturday, September 30. The rally will be held at the City Park in Herculaneum, 776 Joachim Avenue and is sponsored by the Jefferson County Firefighters Association. The rally "kicks off" at 9:00 am with a parade of fire and EMS apparatus. The parade begins at St. Pius X High School and ends at the city park. The opening ceremony begins at 10:00 am with introductions of the parade grand marshals, a memorial service and the presentation of the county fire & EMS awards.

The annual fire engine rally features a static display of fire apparatus, EMS apparatus, air rescue helicopters, firefighter competitions and demonstrations. There are numerous activities planned for the children including a scavenger hunt, a photo booth, a bounce house & inflatable slide, a fire safety house, children firefighter games and a children's firefighter challenge. The eclipse viewing glasses are being sold for \$1.00 each and are available at Herculaneum City Hall and Bloomsdale Bank in Herculaneum. Residents are encouraged to purchase the viewing glasses early to ensure that glasses will be available for the August 21 eclipse.

Other eclipse memorabilia available at city hall includes a commemorative eclipse coin (\$10.00), commemorative post-marked envelopes (\$3.00), commemorative t-shirts (\$15.00 adult & \$10.00 child) and commemorative baseball hats (\$15.00).
