CHANGES IN THE 2015 MOVIES IN THE PARK SCHEDULE

The 2015 Movies in the Park series will continue during the month of July with two major changes in the schedule.

Heavy rain and wet field conditions forced the postponement of the June 20 showing of the movie, Paddington. This movie has been rescheduled and will now be shown on Saturday, July 11 beginning at approximately 8:30 pm.

The movie Cinderella, originally scheduled to be shown on July 11, has been cancelled due to the movie not being available for outdoor showing until September 15. This cancellation is the result of a change in the Walt Disney Studios release date for the movie.

With these two changes, the new lineup for the 2015 Movies in the Park series is:

- Saturday, August 8 - Planes: Fire & Rescue**

All movies are shown on the outdoor movie screen at the Herculaneum City Park, 850 Joachim Avenue. All movies begin at approximately 8:30 pm. Admission and parking are free of charge.

Attendees should bring their own chairs, blankets, insect repellents, etc. to make their evening enjoyable. Concessions will be available at the park.

CITY PET LICENSES NOW DUE

Herculaneum City Ordinance 225.030 requires animal license tags for any dog, cat or other animal over the age of six (6) months.

Owners can purchase the pet tags at Herculaneum City Hall for \$5.00 per animal. Pet owners must provide proof of their pet's vaccination(s) from a veterinarian. Pet tags are valid from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. Pet tags are invaluable in assisting city employees with identifying lost pets and reuniting them with their owners.

NEW HERCULANEUM FARMERS' MARKET SET TO OPEN TUESDAY, JULY 7

Dixie Lee's Farmers' Market in Herculaneum is set to open on Tuesday, July 7 at the Herculaneum City Park, 850 Joachim Avenue. The market will be open on each Tuesday through October 27 from 3:30 pm - 7:30 pm. The farmers' market is sponsored by Herculaneum Today and Tomorrow (HT&T).

The farmers' market is open to locals farmers and vendors who offer fruits, vegetables, meats, spices, eggs, baked goods, herbs, mushrooms, honey, jellies/jams, homemade candies, dry soup mixes & baking mixes, etc. A limited number of vendor spaces for artisans will be available.

UPDATE ON "KADE'S PLAYGROUND"

Heavy rains have slowed the work being done for the building of Kade's Playground, the universally accessible playground being built in the Herculaneum City Park on Joachim Avenue.

The excavation of the playground/parking area has been completed. The next step in the construction phase will be the placement of rock as the site is brought to construction grade. Once the rock is in place, a concrete pad for the volcano structure will be poured as well as the concrete retaining walls that are part of the playground.

Representatives from the playground companies that are supplying the playground pieces will be on site to begin the actual placement of the playground pieces. All playground pieces have been constructed and are awaiting shipment to the playground site. At a date to be determined, local volunteers will be allowed to participate in the Community Build Day.

Signage for the playground is also being designed by a local sign company. Signage will include the names of playground donors, the three sponsorship clubs, a brief history of the volcano theme and other pertinent information.

The official ribbon cutting and grand opening ceremony for the playground will be held later this summer. Watch future issues of the city newsletter for updates and announcement of the community build, ribbon cutting and grand opening ceremonies. Fundraising for the playground project has ended, although new fundraising activities are underway for the Phase II Splash Pad project.

SPLASH PAD AT "KADE'S PLAYGROUND"

Phase II of the Kade's Playground project will include the installation of a water splash pad located adjacent to the playground.

The Splash Pad will include numerous water spray features including palm tree showers, a column arch, a boulder fountain, a spraying ship hull and a ship mast w/custom banners. Other features will include stream jets, a shape spray stand, a misting spray, a mega fan spray, bubblers and side wall streams.

Fundraising for the Phase II - Kade's Splash Pad is now underway. A dinner/auction fundraiser is being planned for later this fall.
