DUNKLIN-FLETCHER "4TH OF JULY PARADE" TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, JULY 2

The Fourth Annual Herculaneum Dunklin Fletcher Fourth of July Parade is scheduled for 11:00 am on Saturday, July 2.

The parade lineup begins at 10:00 am at the Senn-Thomas Middle School on North Main Street. The parade will travel along Joachim Avenue and end at Herculaneum City Park.

The parade is open to all types of entries including decorated vehicles of all types, walking units, motorcycles, classic cars, political entries, family or individual entries, tractors, bicycles, pets and their owners, business entries, organizational entries, school and church groups and emergency vehicles. Applications are available at City Hall or on the city web site www.cityofherculaneum.org.

Trophies will be awarded in the following categories: Best Patriotic Entry - Individual/Family; Best Patriotic Entry - Local Business, Best Patriotic Entry - Organization and a Judge's Award. Trophies will be presented at the Opening Ceremony following the parade.

Five hundred numbered flags will be distributed to those watching along the parade route. A flag number will be drawn during the opening ceremony and the holder of that flag will win an attendance prize valued at \$100.00 or more. The holder of the selected flag must be present at the time of the drawing to win.

SCENIC DRIVE PHASE II PROJECT TO BEGIN JUNE 13

Construction on Phase II of the Scenic Drive road improvement project is scheduled to begin on Monday, June 13.

Improvements will be made to Scenic Drive from McNutt Street to the top of the hill near Scenic Nursing Center. The new improvements will include a new concrete roadway, street lights, storm drains and sidewalks on both sides of the street.

Construction will begin with the closure of Scenic Drive at McNutt Street.

Throughout the project, there will be road closures, detours and rerouting of traffic. The entire project will require a minimum of 120 calendar days.

CITY PET TAGS DUE JULY 1

Herculaneum City Ordinance 225.030 requires animal tags for any dog, cat or other animal over the age of six (6) months. Pet tags can be purchased at Herculaneum City Hall for \$5.00 per tag. Pet owners must provide proof of their pet's vaccinations from a veterinarian. Pet tags are valid from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

Pet tags are valuable in assisting city employees with identifying lost pets and reuniting them with their owners.
