The Herculaneum Park Board will host a Dinner/Auction to benefit the Bay of Naples Splash Zone at Kade’s Playground on Saturday, November 7. The dinner auction will be held at the Meramec Arnold Elks Lodge , 1515 Miller Road in Arnold, The doors will open at 6:00 pm with dinner being served at 7:00 pm.

The splash zone will include numerous water spray features including palm tree showers, a column arch, a boulder fountain, a spraying ship hull and a ship mast w/custom banners. Other features will include stream jets, a shape spray stand, a misting spray, a mega fan spray, bubblers and side wall streams.

22nd ANNUAL JEFFCO FIRE ENGINE RALLY SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 26

The 22nd Annual Jeffco Fire Engine Rally will be held on Saturday, September 26. The rally will be held at the City Park in Herculaneum, 850 Joachim Avenue and is sponsored by the Jefferson County Firefighters Association. The rally “kicks off” at 9:00 am with a parade of fire and EMS apparatus. The parade begins at St. Pius X High School and ends at the city park. The opening ceremony begins at 10:00 am with introductions of the parade grand marshals, a memorial service and the presentation of the county fire & EMS awards.

The annual fire engine rally features a static display of fire apparatus, EMS apparatus & air rescue helicopters, firefighter competitions and demonstrations. There are numerous activities planned for the children including a scavenger hunt, a photo booth, a bounce house & inflatable slide, a fire safety house, children firefighter games and a children’s firefighter challenge. HERCULANEUM FIRE DEPARTMENT SPONSORS 21st CERT (COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM) TRAINING CLASS ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 23 - SUNDAY, OCTOBER 25

The Herculaneum Fire Department will sponsor their twenty-first CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) training class beginning on Friday, October 23 from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The 20-hour training class will be held at the Herculaneum Fire Department, 151 Riverview Plaza Drive, and is open to all residents (18 years and older) of Herculaneum and the surrounding communities.

The class is free of charge and requires no prior training. All participants will receive a personal emergency backpack and a certificate of completion.

FOURTH ANNUAL VETERANS DAY PARADE & VETERANS RECOGNITION CEREMONY SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 8

The fourth annual Veterans Day Parade and Ceremony is scheduled for Sunday, November 8 at 2:00 pm. The parade will begin from the Senn-Thomas Middle School on North Main Street and travel along Joachim Avenue ending at the City Park .

The parade is open to all organizations, school groups, church groups, service organizations, families and individuals. Motorized units, walking units, family or individual entries are all welcome. This is an excellent opportunity to show your support of our veterans, active military personnel and/or a family member. Trophies will be awarded for best organizational entry, best family entry, best local business entry and Judge's Award.

Immediately following the parade, the 4th Annual Veterans Day Ceremony will take place at the Herculaneum City Park (approximately 3:00 pm). The ceremony will include the presentation of colors by Jefferson County Sheriffs' Office Color Guard, the introduction of the parade grand marshal and a city proclamation honoring all veterans. The ceremony will also include a 21-gun salute, patriotic music and presentations by Herculaneum High School students. As part of the ceremony, seven Herculaneum residents who were killed in action during World War II and Vietnam will be remembered. All veterans in attendance will be individually recognized.

A bald eagle from the World Bird Sanctuary will participate in the parade and be available for photos following the ceremony.
